1.1.16 Cell Phone Use While in Control of all Vehicles and Equipment:

The purpose of the policy is to vest in the Supervisor or their designate, the authority to enforce reasonable rules relating to electronic communication devices in the work place. This policy covers both MD issued devices and personally owned devices.

Definition:

An electronic communication device includes cellular and PCS telephones, camera telephones, Personal Digital Assistants (PDA's), two-way radios or video broadcasting devices, pagers, and any other device that allows a person to record and/or transmit, on either real time or delayed basis, sound, video, or still images, text, or other information.

Policy:

- 1) Make safe driving your first priority.
- 2) Let your voice mail services take your incoming calls.
- 3) Only hands-free devices are to be used while operating M.D. equipment or vehicles.
- 4) Pull over, when safe to do so, before answering cell phone or making calls.
- 5) Avoid stressful or emotional conversations.
- 6) Ensure you know your wireless phone and its features such as speed dial and redial.
- 7) Personal use of MD issued devices is prohibited except in an emergency or with pre-approval from the supervisor.
- 8) Employees have no expectation of privacy in using MD issued communications devices.
- 9) Loss, theft or damage to an MD issued device must be reported immediately to the Supervisor. If loss, theft or damage occurs as a result of employee negligence, the employee to whom the device is assigned will be responsible for reimbursing the MD for the repair or replacement costs.
- 10) No employee is to use the communications device for the purpose of illegal transactions, harassment, obscene or offensive behavior or other violations of MD policy or federal, provincial or local laws.
- 11) If the MD determines that the employee no longer needs the communications device to perform the employee's job responsibilities, any fees or charges associated with cancellation of the service contract shall be the responsibility of the MD.
- 12) Should an employee receive a "violation ticket" for an infraction under section 115.1 (1) of Bill 16 Traffic Safety (Distracted Driving)

 Amendment Act, 2010, all fines, fees and levies shall be covered by the employee.
- 13) There will be no "texting" or "game playing" during M.D. company time.
