He would like to see us using a diesel exhaust fluid tier 4 if possible. The grader issues were discussed and Council was advised that it is all related to fluffy snow. Technical support has been provided and the machines should be good for the whole winter now. Director of Public Works advised that field support has been good this year, noting that the Finning Tech has stepped up to the plate. Soft and hard codes were discussed and the municipality is implementing something at our end so the information gets to the tech quicker. Doug Veretonik advised that more manpower is being injected into the areas that have more machines. A question about the satellite system was proposed and Finning advised that they are in the process of getting the field techs on the system and utilizing the system once the municipality has called in a code. Randy Mabbutt wondered what Council knew about the NJPA (National Joint Power Alliance. He noted that Caterpillar is a member and that the association does the leg work and the municipality can utilize the information. Reeve Barss advised that the M.D. will look at the NJPA at tender time and that the AAMDC will be updating the municipalities at the next regional meeting. Council discussed operating leases, capital leases, rental agreements and guaranteed buy backs. Finning noted that they appreciate the municipality and thanked Council for their business.
