If a farm family meets the requirements, fill out and an approval process will be undertaken by the Agricultural Service Board. Successful applicants will be contacted by a representative of the Agricultural Service Board and presented with the 100 Year Farm Family Plaque.

Your family will receive a plaque commemorating this 100 year milestone. This award which can be placed at the gate or hung on a building symbolizes your family's perseverance in sustaining their ranch/farm through ever changing times and the contribution they make to our agriculture industry.

Are You Eligible?

There are many century farms and ranches in Alberta. Criteria has been set to identify these families. It includes the following:

- Your land must be owned by your family for 100 or more years.
- You can provide evidence clearly demonstrating the kinship ties between you and the founder of the farm, ranch or homestead.
- You can provide the date of homestead establishment
- You can provide the ownership land title
- The current size of the original homestead must be at least 160 acres of land
