Coverage must be kept in good standing with WCB or a hold back will be kept to cover any liability incurred by the M.D. on the contractors' behalf. The payroll clerk shall notify the Director of Transportation of any gravel contractors that are not in compliance with this section by March 31 of each year. Gravel Hauling Contractors will not be eligible to work for the M.D. without proof of insurance and WCB clearance as per this section.

TEXAS GATES

The applicant shall be responsible for the entire construction and installation costs of the Texas gate. They also shall carry at least \$5,000,000 in liability insurance that will hold harmless and indemnify at all times the M.D. of Wainwright No. 61 against all claims for damages or other claims which may arise attributable to the existence and use of the Texas gate on the municipal road. The M.D. shall be specifically named as an additional insured on the policy.
