

Municipal District of Wainwright No. 61
Notice

The Municipal District (MD) of Wainwright No. 61, in accordance with Section 22 of the *Municipal Government Act*, Chapter M26.1, Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000, as amended, proposes to close and dispose of portions of roads in the locality of Ribstone as shown on Schedule "A" and Schedule "B".

To be Closed and Disposed of:

1. Lane within Block 1, Plan 1760BK, containing 0.132 ha. (0.33 acre) more or less. Excepting thereout all mines and minerals.
2. All that portion of King Street South which lies north of First Avenue South, Plan 1760BK, containing 0.324 ha. (0.80 acre) more or less. Excepting thereout all mines and minerals.
3. The most westerly 184.50 metres in perpendicular width throughout of First Avenue South, Plan 1760 BK, containing 0.371 ha. (0.92 acre) more or less. Excepting thereout all mines and minerals.
4. All that portion of First Avenue North, which lies west of Main Street North, Plan 1760BK, containing 0.080 ha. (0.20 acre) more or less. Excepting thereout all mines and minerals.
5. All that portion of Second Avenue North which lies west of Main Street North, Plan 1760BK, containing 0.080 ha. (0.20 acre) more or less. Excepting thereout all mines and minerals.
6. All of Road Plan 992 5128, containing 0.037 ha. (0.09 acre) more or less. Excepting thereout all mines and minerals.
