Please note if you are enrolled in an agriculture or environmental program please apply for the ASB bursary.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

- The successful applicant will receive a financial award of \$1,000
- The applicant must be a resident of the M.D. of Wainwright (Village of Irma, Edgerton and Chauvin, and Town of Wainwright residents are not eligible to apply)
- The applicant must be accepted to or currently attending a program at an accredited post-secondary institution
- No applicant is eligible to receive more than one M.D. of Wainwright bursary in their academic career
- Applicant may only apply for one M.D. bursary per year
- Children of Municipal Councillors and staff are not eligible to apply
- Incomplete applications will be disregarded
- The successful bursary candidate will be contacted directly by M.D. of Wainwright administrative staff
- The application deadline is September 1st annually
