

## Dyer's Woad Isatis tinctoria Brassicaceae (Mustard Family)

## **Prohibited Noxious**









- Life cycle: Winter annual, biennial or short-lived perennial.
- **Root:** Taproot and some lateral roots.
- Leaves: All leaves bluish-green with white midrib. Rosette leaves have long slender stalks, are widest near the tip and covered with soft hairs. Stem leaves lack hairs, are alternate, lance shaped, and clasp the stem.
- Stems: 30 120cm tall, multi-branching.
- Flower: Cluster on upper stem in a flattopped inflorescence. Yellow petals 3mm long and wide.
- •Seed/Fruit: Purplish brown, tear drop shaped seed pods hang from small stalks.
- · Control: Chemical.
