- Information: Originated in Russia, similar to Winter Wheat, Wheat and Jointed Goatgrass are genetically related and can hybridize.
- Life Cycle: Winter annual.
- Root: Fibrous root.
- Leaves: Hairy on the leaf edge.
- Stems: Erect 40-80cm tall, hairy auricles.
- Flower: Spike, long awned glumes on upper spikelets, 2-4 flowers per spikelet.
- Seed/Fruits: 2 seeds per spikelet.
- Toxicity:
- Control: Use clean seed, certificate of seed analysis, destroy plants before seed set.
