

- . Life cycle: Creeping Perennial.
- . Root: Aggressive, rhizomatous, deep.
- . Leaves: Blue green to gray green leaves are alternate, covered with soft white hairs, and lance- to arrow head shaped. Lower leaves stalked; upper leaves clasp stem.
- . Stems: Up to 60cm tall.
- . Flower: Numerous white flowers with four petals borne on 1cm long stalk. Dense clusters create white, flat-top appearance.
- Seed/Fruit: Seed capsules heart shaped with two reddish brown seeds.
- . **Toxic:** May be toxic to cattle.
- . Control: Chemical, cultivation or mowing may increase populations.
